We also spoke on an upcoming ride for St Jude's at Love Valley closer to fall; there will be information to follow later this summer on it.

Brad spoke about the maps; the GPS'ing of the trails and that they would be at the June meeting for sale. Brad also informed us about a meeting with the two representatives from NCSU in Raleigh who holds our lease. On May 18th; Ted Johnson, Ed Spivey, Steve White & Brad Caldwell met with Larry Hancock & Ken Burgess concerning upcoming logging and our lease at the last pavilion at A-A. Brad presented a Power Point presentation showing the condition of the camp when we first acquired it and the way it looks today. Larry and Ken were very impressed with it and took a copy with them to show at NCSU. They explained to us that all NCSU lands are under a forestry management program and the small area that covers the BLUE trail is slated for logging. Our group posed many questions to these guys about the logging. Logging this area should begin and end this summer; we have asked them to push our trail road back out after they are finished and they agreed to this. It will be under natural regeneration, not replanting and they will leave a buffer zone around the small creeks and boundary lines as well as along the driveway. They are under contract to repair any damage to grass, fields, creek crossing, driveway, etc before they leave. We have requested that when the times for our next section to be cut, (which could be a few years away) for them to cut the 35+- acres across the road from us that we do not currently use. There is also currently some logging going on in the USFS land around us. We know this is inconvenient if a trail is temporarily blocked but remember; that 90% of our trails are on old logging roads from 50-60 years ago and without them; we wouldn't be able to ride as much as we do now. Hopefully when this is finished; we will gain a few more trails out of it. Brad asked them about our current lease since we are about to begin our final year; they told us that they were very happy with us and another 3 year with (2) 1 year options would not be a problem; they explained to us that any lease of 5 years or more has to go through a whole new group of people and rules & that it would be faster and easier to keep renewing 3 years leases with options. Larry made a note to proceed with our new lease 30 days before our current one expires per NCSU rules. He also commented that they have had letters and emails about how well the camp looks now and a lease renewal will not be a problem at all. We all walked away feeling it was a good meeting and they were very happy with BRHA's role at Anita-Alta.

PAST RIDE

For the 5th year in a row, the 2 Day Camp N Ride trip sponsored by Rick Cannon & Matt Hall went extremely well! Over the years Rick & Matt have sponsored this ride; they have gathered what volunteers they could, to help with the preparations of it and to trim out the 16+ miles one way for this ride; but this year Rick and his wife Nancy cleaned, trimmed and marked it by themselves- BRHA would like to give them a big THANK YOU for making sure we had a clean trail to ride with no "face-slappers". This year, we had great weather and since the ride was 90% shaded; the hot temps didn't bother us much at all. Camping out in tents was also very nice, not too hot or too cold! We had 32 riders leave out from Steve White's barn in Caldwell County Sat. morning on their way to Boone's Falls, Boomer, NC. We rode across the ridge into Alexander County and down into Wilkes County to camp. Thanks to Joe Phillips for allowing us free use of his campground again this year! The group collected donations before we left for payment of food; & it was decided to pay for Joe's 2011 BRHA membership with some of those funds; also, we want to thank Tommy Bumgarner for hauling our cargo trailer to the campsite and back to Steve's barn when we were done. We also donated Tommy \$30 for his fuel for two trips in his truck to do this. Thanks to Brad Caldwell for donating a round bale for our horse hay. We collected \$285 through donations total and after paying out \$60 and paying BRHA back \$205 for the food; we had a net profit to BRHA of \$20. We lost a few riders Sunday morning due to unsure reasons, (either sore horses or sore people); but for the crowd that did ride out and back; they rode over 37 miles. Around 7 hours or more each day! Thanks also to Matt Hall, Brad Caldwell & Wendy Johnson for helping with all the setup of high-lines and the bathroom tent; BRHA would also like to especially thank Lewis Ford for allowing us passage across his land for this ride without which the ride would not be possible & to Steve White for allowing use of his barn as the starting & ending point and to our cook masters: Roger Adkins, Kathie Adkins, Ted & Wendy Johnson, Rick Cannon, BJ & Jill

Moretz & Darlene Engle; everyone appreciated your hard work in preparing us Dinner and Breakfast!
Thanks again Rick & Matt for sponsoring our 5th great 2 day ride!

The Forest Service has asked that we **do not tie our horses to the trees.**

Please Please Please...Do Not Ride Your Horses to the Public Campground at Boone Fork Park. This is for campers only. NO HORSES; Horses are only allowed to be in the old Horse Campground at the back of the park. Ride around the forest gate to access the old horse camp and pit toilets and Orange/White trail. This trail has NOT been marked yet, but it is at the back of the park.

If you smoke cigarettes, please don't throw your butts down, please place them in an empty bottle or something.

If you must use paper on trail when you use the bathroom, please don't leave it in the middle of the trail.

We are finding a lot of trash, cans, and bottles on the trails, again if you can "**Pack it in, you can Pack it out**". We are aware that all the trash on the trails is not from horseback riders, but since we are the largest user on the trail, we will more than likely get the blame. If you are off your horse and see trash, please pick it up. Thanks

MAID SERVICE- Please be aware that according to our By Laws that each member must supply their OWN toilet and that BRHA makes no guarantee that a campground bathroom will be available for you to use; also, please be aware that our caretaker; Laura Lail, is 100% volunteer; in taking calls, returning calls, checking trails, mowing, selling BRHA store goods, selling memberships, checking the gates, checking parking permits, handling group rentals, etc. BRHA does NOT pay Laura to keep the bathrooms clean; so if you see something that needs attention; please go the extra mile and take care of it. Better yet, a good rule of thumb would be to always leave the bathroom your using cleaner than you found it.

Leave only footprint, hoof prints and paw prints.
